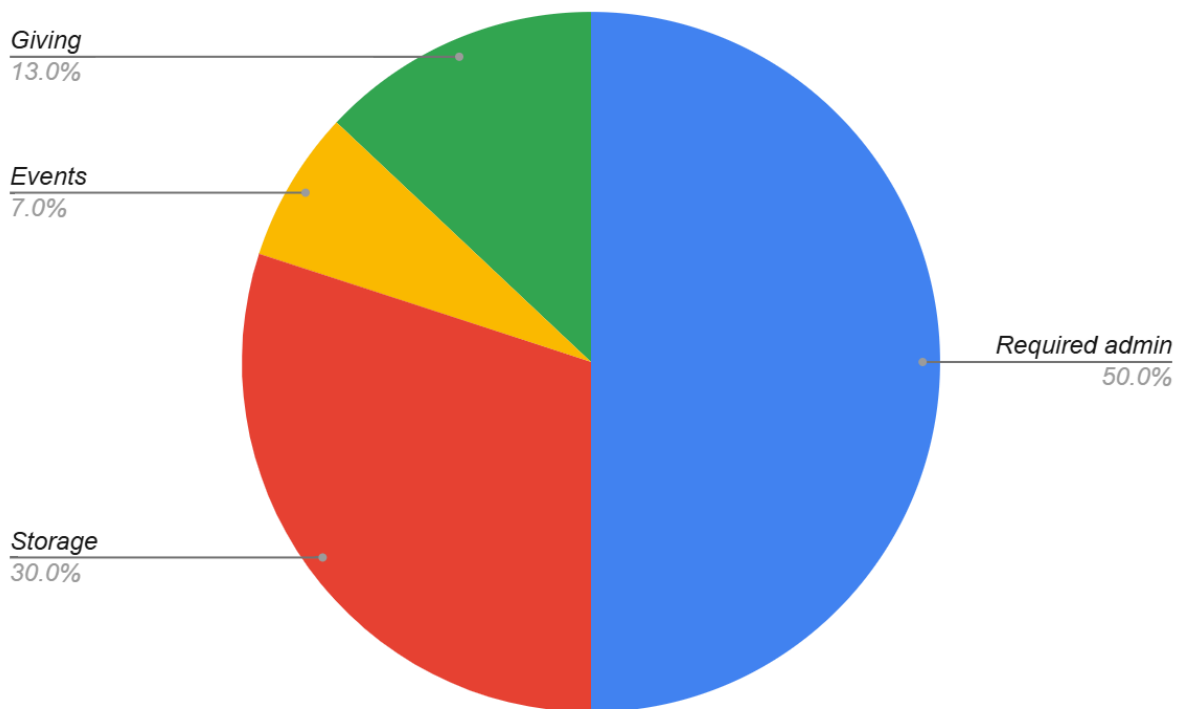

Each of these programs are designed to financially support themselves and we have been blessed to see them flourish. Beyond these programs, your annual membership is used for two purposes: to host select FISH events and to cover general business expenses. While ministry directors can elect to use their ministry funds to provide small stipends or thank volunteers, no board members, coaches, teachers, or volunteers are paid or have any expenses (meals, transportation, etc.) covered by your annual membership.
